

The UK's housing crisis is no accident, but has been carefully orchestrated to become a catchall excuse for self-serving projects. The housing crisis isn't a crisis. Calling it one inhibits effective action and plays into the hands of its creators. To respond strategically to the crippling British homes shortage we must abolish the term "housing crisis" entirely and call it what it is – a design project.








"3D printing existed even 20, 30 years ago, but it was either done with lesser materials or it was extremely expensive,"
